Looking for Resources?

Sometimes knowing where to get the resources you need is half the challenge. Here are some resources available in Victoria that we often get inquiries about.

Odd Job Help: Many seniors need help with odd jobs around the house. You can hire a Student from The University of Victoria by calling Career Services at 250-721-8421. They will give you contact information for students looking for odd jobs. Also, there are both Saanich Volunteer Services and Oak Bay Volunteer Services who may be able to assist you. Alternatively, there are numerous professional organizations here in Victoria that will come and do light housework, odd jobs, laundry, shopping, etc. Most are listed in the blue Seniors Services Directory which can be picked up from either of Silver Threads Centres.



Transportation: Transportation can be tricky, especially once we have retired from driving. BC Transit offers a service called Handy DART. They will pick you up and take you home for the same price as regular transit; to inquire about your eligibility call 250-727-7811. Handy DART users, too, qualify for Taxi Savers. Taxi Savers provide you with half-off your taxi fare. Booklets are sold for \$40.00 containing \$80.00 worth of coupons. Further, If you would like to come to our 'Guess Who's Coming to Dinner' evenings at the Saanich Centre, we have volunteer drivers who can pick you up and take you home! Also, the number 8 Bus easily goes between our two centres allowing straightforward access to all of the programs we have to offer.

Housing: Depending on your income, you could qualify for rent subsidies through BC Housing's SAFER Program. Information regarding eligibility requirements and application forms can be picked up from our resource areas at either centre. If you need assistance filling out the application forms our Senior Mentors are happy to help! Also, in the Senior's Services Directory there are listings of housing options available in Victoria.

As always our Silver Threads staff are happy to help you by suggesting programs and services at Silver Threads and/or providing you with information on services that are offered elsewhere. Do not hesitate to ask and we will always do our best help you find what you need!





Sandi has been volunteering for over 4 years with Silver Threads as a part of our Senior Mentoring program. In the program, volunteers help seniors to complete complex forms issued by the government and other agencies which individuals can often find a very daunting process. Sandi first became



acquainted with Silver Threads in 1984 when she lived in the neighbourhood and helped to serve tea and coffee at dances held at the Saanich Centre.

Sandi hails from Manitoba where she went to school in Virden and Brandon. Sandi moved to British Columbia in 1983 as she had parents in Qualicum Beach and a sister in Victoria. In 1988, Sandi got a job with the Family Maintenance Enforcement Program (FMEP) where she spent the next 22 years. She was with FMEP from the start of the program, beginning her career as an Enforcement Assistant and ending as the Office Administrator for the regional office, overseeing a staff of 60+.

After she retired, Sandi realized that she would need to do something to keep herself busy so she started looking for volunteer work. As well as her involvement with the Senior Mentoring program, Sandi also volunteers with UVic, co-facilitating self-management programs, and in the gift shop at the Victoria General Hospital. She also does home support work with Nurse Next Door and is an active member of her Red Hat group. Sandi loves her many community involvements, and we are so appreciative of the time she gives to us here at Silver Threads.
