Volunteer: Bradley

Bradley was first introduced to Silver Threads in 2015 while doing research for a school project. The assignment tasked a group of students to partner with a local organization and create a project that would positively affect people living in the community. The group decided to focus on seniors and technologies; emphasizing the importance of digital communication in the 21st Century. Bradley and the group raised funds to purchase Silver Threads a large tablet. They also offered a lesson on iPads and tablets to an initial group of 4 seniors. The project was well received and after the first tutorial Bradley proposed to continue offering lessons when needed.

Since then Bradley has graduated with a diploma in Community, Family, and Child Studies. He now works full-time with a foster care organization in the Greater Victoria Area. When needed, Bradley finds time to stop in for an hour and help out individuals or groups with their technology concerns. Lessons have included purchasing questions, trouble shooting needs or basic tutorials.

Bradley grew up in the Comox Valley. His mother works for a seniors residential health lodge and when Bradley was a teenager he would often volunteer there. In the early 2000's Bradley helped the lodge purchase computers for the residents and began teaching tutorials. In his early 20's Bradley moved to Victoria and began working for the Geek Squad.

We greatly appreciate Bradley taking the time to volunteer with Silver Threads and helping our seniors navigate computers and technology. Thanks you so much Bradley!
