

2016-2017 Annual Report Now Available

Silver Threads Service's year end was March 31st. During April and May we reviewed our finances, programs, and statistics and presented the results at our Annual General Meeting at the Saanich Centre on June 21st, 2017.

We have had a positive 2016-2017 and are pleased with our results. Notably, the growth in Program and Membership participation and revenue. Our membership is the highest it has been in ten years, and we have generated \$25,000 more in program revenue than the previous year. Our Outreach Program has expanded. We are now offering six Memory PLUS groups a week. We completed a Project to help seniors in rental housing in Victoria and Saanich, and we have established new partnerships that include the MS Society.

We thank our members and participants for adding to the vibrancy and positive energy in the centres, helping to increase our donations by 30%, and making Silver Threads Service a great place to be.

At the Annual General Meeting our volunteer Board of Directors was confirmed and includes returning members Barbara Harwood, Sara Pash, Doug Crowder, Andy Robinson, Norm Tatlow, and Directors Kathy Ajas, Marjorie Moulton and Margaret Jacobson. The quick business meeting was followed by a delicious roast beef dinner and entertainment by singer Maureen Washington. It was a lovely celebration to end a great year.


