In April, thanks to the Rapid Relief Fund lead by The Victoria Foundation, the Jawl Foundation and the Times Colonist and the Greater Victoria community for their fundraising efforts that provided funds to Silver Threads Service to start a Meal Program for seniors during the Pandemic. Additional funding from United Way Greater Victoria and Island Saving Credit Union have allowed the program to continue into 2021.

With these generous donations and support from our community partners we are able to provide frozen meals prepared by the Island Health Authority Soup-er Meal Program, breads from Cobbs Bread Bakery and produce from the Food Share Network.

During this challenging time it is our intention to do what we can to help those in our community. If you or someone you know is in need of support, please let us know. At Silver Threads we accept people and whatever they are facing without judgement. None of us can fully know what our neighbours and friends may be struggling with, and right now there is no shortage of struggles.
