Open House Week - September 7th to 10th

Silver Threads Service will be hosting an Open House Week at our two convenient locations September 7th to 10th from 9:00am to 3:30pm. With more of us being fully vaccinated and being mindful of continuing safety protocols we will be gradually adding new and old favourites of our programs and services this fall. It's time to safely reconnect to the places and people that will bring you good health and happiness.

Our centres are located in Saanich at 286 Hampton Road and in Victoria at 1911 Quadra Street. Membership as of September 1st will be \$35 and is valid to March 31st, 2022 and gives you access to both centres. If you visit us during the Open House Week and renew or take out a membership, along with a new STS membership card we can also laminate a copy of your vaccination card if you have had both shots. People have asked where they can get their vaccine cards laminated and we are happy to offer this service. Note that there will be a different process for the Provincial Vaccination Plan.

Older Adults are welcome to stop by, have a tour, enjoy a fresh lemonade and treat. Since the pandemic started in March of 2020, we moved the Victoria Centre into a newly renovated facility and we cleaned and spruced up the Saanich Centre, so if you haven't been in during the past year please do stop by and see the changes. There will be a number of free activities planned for folks to try out. Tai Chi Therapy, Table Tennis, Art for Anyone, and Online Program demos. Space will be limited for the classes in keeping with safety protocols so please call to book your spot. The Treasure Trove and Silver Spoons Café will also be open at the Saanich Centre. COVID-19 Safety Plan

Silver Threads Service is following the Provincial Health Order and will require proof of vaccination to access programs and services. Starting September 13th, all staff, instructors, volunteers and participants must have at least one dose of a COVID-19 vaccine. By October 24th, all must be fully vaccinated. Silver Threads Service will ask to see proof of vaccination and valid government ID. The requirement is in place until January 31, 2022, subject to extension.

Silver Threads Service will continue to implement the COVID Safety Plan that includes tracking, health checks, sanitization, small group size, physical distancing and mask wearing. Masks are now mandatory in the centres but can be removed during exercise or when eating and drinking when physical distancing can be maintained.

Your attendance in all Programs must be pre-booked by signing up at Reception or calling the Centres.

Note: There are some specific programs that will require all participants to be fully vaccinated to protect our Instructors and each other from possible exposure. This includes all One on One appointments, Victoria Computer Club, Ukulele, all Choirs and singing, Bridge and Games.

More than Meals Program

After 17 months the More Than Meals Program started at the beginning of the Pandemic that officially wrapped up on August 26th. A team of 15 Volunteers led by Anne, Ro and Donene managed the Program during these challenging time with incredible results that include:

- Delivering 7,837 Meals
- 3,375 Visits
- Distributing \$117,000 worth of groceries
