COVID-19 Safety Plan

Silver Threads Service is following the Provincial Health Order and will require proof of vaccination to access programs and services. As of October 24th all staff, instructors, volunteers and participants must be fully vaccinated. Silver Threads Service will ask to see proof of vaccination and valid government ID. The requirement is in place until January 31, 2022, subject to extension.

Silver Threads Service will continue to implement the COVID Safety Plan that includes tracking, health checks, sanitization, small group size, physical distancing and mask wearing. Masks continue to be mandatory in the centres but can be removed during exercise or when eating and drinking when physical distancing can be maintained. Your attendance in all Programs must be pre-booked by signing up at Reception or calling the Centres.

Be Tech Prepared

Covid-19 is still with us and now we have a State of Emergency in BC. With the continuing supply chain and chip shortage for our tech gadgets, some may find they have a hard time getting what tech they require and may have to just use what they have. Perhaps it's time to make sure all your devices are running as they should.

- Make sure they are updated to the latest operating system or software updates on your phones, tablets, laptops, PC's, Apple devices, Chromebooks.
- Delete unused Apps, Software programs you never use, files you have downloaded and no longer require, pictures on the physical device
- Ensure you are running up to date virus scanning and malware programs on your devices if needed
- · Backup what is required in case of failure
- Make sure your devices are charged and possibly get a power pack to charge when the power is out or there is no access to power
