Silver Threads Service celebrated 65 years of service in 2021 and we are now working towards our next 65 of serving older adults in Greater Victoria. Over the past two years with COVID, the organization has been tested as the rest of the world has been, and here we are in 2022 rebuilding and continuing to thrive. Our focus is to strengthen our two Centres and provide safe, secure programs and services for older adults. In Greater Victoria, 95% of older adults are living independently in the community. The vast majority live alone. While the range for support needed is vast and often directly related to health, there is a consistent thread that everyone wants to feel connected to peers and services to enhance their quality of life, and to have a purpose, especially after the pandemic. That is the mission and mandate of Silver Threads Service.

For someone like Doreen, who is regaining balance, strength, and range of motion after a fall, the twice a week Functional Fitness Classes are helping her feel that she can continue to live safely at home and has reassured her daughter. Gary comes to the Saanich Centre weekly and has coffee with a couple of acquaintances turned friends. Afterwards he connects to the Food Share Programs and picks up free produce, bread, canned goods, and hygiene products that help him manage rising food costs on a limited budget. Cathy has been on the Telephone Reassurance Program since the start of COVID and starts each day answering her phone and checking in with our volunteer caller. She says having a daily chat for

a few minutes is a good start to her day and puts her in the right frame of mind to have connected with someone who cares.
