Be aware of Scams

Just like spring, this is the time of year when scammers get active claiming to be a government agency like Canada Revenue, Canada Border Services Agency, or Service Canada. The government does not ask for payment in gift cards, or Bitcoin. Scammers count on you panicking. As always, if you get an urgent email or phone call from someone at a government agency asking for information, reveal nothing and phone Service Canada at 1-800-622-6232. Do not use a phone number provided by the caller, or click on a link in the suspicious email. To protect yourself from fraud, get help from the Victoria Computer Club. Or you can browse to <u>canada.ca</u> and scroll down to the bottom of the page, looking for "Be Scam Smart"
