Future of the Victoria Centre

Silver Threads Service is at a decision point regarding the future of the Victoria Centre. Our goal is to keep the Victoria Centre open past March 31st, 2025, however we cannot continue to subsidize \$50K out of our annual operating budget.

Why? The Victoria Centre is part of the City of Victoria's decentralized model of service delivery. There are 11 Community and Senior Centres that are a part of this network. All except for Silver Threads are in City owned facilities. We are currently the lease holder of the centre on Quadra Street and receive funding from the City to lease the space, but we have a significant shortfall due to paying property tax, and operating costs such as cleaning and hydro. The 10 organizations that

are in City owned buildings have these expenses covered. Having these costs paid by the City, as they are for other network service providers, is critical for us to be able to renew our lease.

The history of the relationship between Silver Threads and the City of Victoria goes back to 1965. We were the first organization to partner on service delivery. We began in a 14,000 square foot City owned, purpose built facility, which we operated for 38 years until the land was sold to make space for the CRD. Since then, we have struggled to find a permanent location that is also financially viable. We have been in the current Quadra Street location since March 2020 and successfully navigated a tough start due to COVID. We now have a solid roster of programs and a great atmosphere thanks to our wonderful members, volunteers and staff.

We want to keep building on the significant progress we have made! There have been previous initiatives to resolve this issue. Our next step is to present to the Mayor and Council on October 10th to ask that they even the playing field for Silver Threads and provide funding to cover the property tax we pay to the City and the facility operating expenses. We are finding that many of our Seniors continue to fall for the scammers, either by phone calls, banking issues, clicking on links in emails or texts and finding themselves in a very unfortunate situation. We offer many classes in person and online via Zoom per our calendar each month. Also, you can get assistance in a 1:1 session at Silver Threads on a Friday morning.

October is Cyber Security Month – It's time to ensure again the following:

- Make sure your devices are up to date with software patches from Microsoft, Apple, or Apps on your phones/tablets. There are updates more than just once per month these days.
- Are your anti-Virus/malware programs working as they should – is there a green check mark or red mark? Always pay attention to this on your PC's/ Laptops
- Do you have an inventory of your digital equipment models, serial numbers?
- Have you changed and secured your passwords either by doing this on a regular basis or have STRONG passwords unique to each account, as well as informing family members of where your passwords are in the event of an illness?
- Are you falling for all the scams and fake emails.

Then it's time to learn about how to stay safe. The <u>VictoriaComputerClub.org</u> website and the Government of Canada website <u>getcyber safe.gc.ca</u> both offer advice on securing your devices.
