The focus of Silver Threads Service during the 2023-24 fiscal year has been to increase Centre-based health, wellness and social programs for a wide range of older adults and a variety of needs and increase participation. Our goal is to ensure quality services and developing a resilient and sustainable organization. 

2023 - 2024 Financial Results

Revenues

Fiscal 2023-24 operating revenue, totaling \$780,813, consists of \$518,142 from grants and donations plus \$262,671 from membership and program fees.

Following is a breakdown of the revenue sources:



Expenditures

Total spending in 2023-24 was \$881,756 resulting in an operating deficit of \$102,230. The 2023-24 spending can be broken down as follows:

Staff wages & benefits \$519,824
Victoria Centre lease, property taxes, operating costs \$173,448
All other expenses \$188,484
Loss on disposal of capital assets \$1,287)
Total \$881,756

Reserves: As of March 31, 2024, there was \$575,817 in reserves/funds balance.
