

We would like to express our gratitude to everyone who attended the presentation to Victoria City Council on October 10th regarding our lease funding. Currently, we do not have a definitive response as the Council is still engaged in budget deliberations. On November 17th, the City Council has invited community organizations that receive \$25,000 or more in financial support from the City to make a presentation, and we are pleased to accept this opportunity. Our presentation will last 10 minutes and will focus on our organization's programs, services, and overall value, with a brief reference to our funding situation. You are welcome to attend in person or view the presentation online. Additional details will be provided as soon as the agenda is finalized.

This month, Silver Threads is launching our Annual Direct mail fundraising campaign, and you can expect to receive information by mail. This important initiative raises funds for our programs and services as our membership and registration fees only cover approximately 30% of our costs. We expect that our fees will not increase in 2025, as we recognize cost of living is ever increasing. If

you are in a situation that you can support Silver Threads this is appreciated. Our goal is to be able to continue to provide a place and purpose for older adults to have a community.

In late November, we will release our Winter Program Guide, which will include all offerings from January to March 2025. This newsletter highlights a selection of new programs, presentations, and workshops designed to engage your interest. Our dedicated staff puts in significant effort to provide you with professional, high-quality health, wellness, educational, and social experiences. We hope you find them enjoyable.

Telephone Reassurance Program

Our Telephone Reassurance Program offers peace of mind for those who live alone and their family members. Each morning by 9:00am our volunteer will call to check in. If they are unable to connect we will reach out to emergency contacts to make sure you are safe. This service is offered Monday to Friday year round and is closed on statutory holidays and weekends. Membership is open to anyone interested in digital devices, and it costs \$25 per person per year to belong to the Victoria Computer Club.
