Income Tax Preparation

In March and April, Income Taxes for 2024 can be filed at both centres through the Canada Revenue Agency's Community Volunteer Income Tax Program (CVITP). Eligibility for Seniors 55+ includes having a moderate income (up to \$35,000 for a single person or \$45,000 for a couple) and a simple tax situation. Appointments will be in person and volunteers will be e-filing all returns. The service is free of charge, and

you can book an appointment once you have all your relevant tax forms.

Remaining appointments at both Centres are for members only.

It's spring and time to be very aware of all the scams that never stop year-round. If anything, they have gotten worse with the introduction of AI (Artificial Intelligence).

This is the time of year when scammers get active claiming to be a government agency like Canada Revenue, Canada Border Services Agency, or Service Canada. Always remember, the government **does not** ask for payment in gift cards, or Bitcoin. Scammers count on you panicking. As always, if you get an urgent email or phone call from someone at a government agency asking for information, reveal nothing and phone Service Canada at I -800-622-6232.

Do not use a phone number provided by the caller or click on a link in the suspicious email. To protect yourself from fraud, get help from the Victoria Computer Club. Or you can browse to <u>Get Cyber Safe</u> (https://www.getcybersafe.gc.ca/en)
